



Meet the “5,000 Farms” that “Support Prop 12”

Prop 12 is a California law, financed by animal rights groups, that bans the sale of affordably priced eggs and pork. The regulation has forced farmers across the country to rebuild barns to be California compliant – a hugely expensive undertaking. Despite the law’s harm to farmers and consumers, animal rights groups seeking to defend burdensome restrictions on animal agriculture claim that “5,000 farms across 39 states support Prop 12.”

The Center for the Environment and Welfare examined this list and discovered that many of these farms aren’t involved in producing pork or eggs.

Below are a selection of the “farms” that these groups cite.



1 LITTLE GOAT FARM AT THE LAKE

Little Goat Farm sells flowers and Nigerian Dwarf Goats. It also offers goat cuddling sessions and “Goat Yoga” classes.



2 HARMONY FARM SANCTUARY

Not only is Harmony Farm Sanctuary not a pork or egg farm, it doesn't even appear to be a farm at all. Instead, the Sanctuary is a living space for various farm animals, and does not produce any sort of agricultural products. Rather than selling products that could be impacted by Prop 12's mandates, the Sanctuary relies on donations and “glamping” rentals.



3 GLOBAL GARDENS CHICAGO

Global Gardens is a 1-acre urban farm in Chicago. The farm is staffed by refugees and produces some vegetables, but no pork or egg products. A majority of the farm's income comes from charitable donations, not selling produce.



4 ABACELA WINERY

Abacela Winery is a winery in Oregon that has a tasting room and offers a selection of whites, reds, and rosé. Abacela does not, however, produce eggs or pork.



5 THE ENGLISH LAVENDER FARM

The English Lavender Farm produces 11 types of lavender and zero types of pork or egg products. The farm's income seems to come from the sale of lavender soaps, oils, and seasonings, all of which are left untouched by Prop 12's harmful mandates.



6 HEMP FARM COLORADO

Hemp Farm Colorado sells a variety of marijuana products, edibles, and vapes. These products are not impacted by Prop 12.
