
Lab-Grown Meat Survey

Conducted January 2024 CARAVAN Omnibus Surveys by Big Village


Methodology

This CARAVAN survey was conducted by Big Village among a sample of 1,008 adults 18 years of age and older. The online omnibus study is conducted three times a week among a demographically representative U.S. sample of 1,000 adults 18 years of age and older. This survey was live on January 22-24, 2024.


LAB-GROWN MEAT SURVEY - JANUARY 2024 (01/22/2024 - 01/24/2024)






L3. Do you believe the government should require lab-grown meat companies to disclose the chemicals used in the growing process?
